Jerry K. made a motion to adjourn meeting.


Meeting ended with The Lord's Prayer.

Thank you to everyone who donated soup for "Souper Bowl Sunday." Zion donated approximately 200 cans to the Illinois Valley Food Pantry!



**March 13**<sup>th</sup> - Spring Valley UCC with Pastor Betty Delgado from Trinity UCC preaching.






Live Life (Pre and Post Transplant Support Group) meets the second Monday of each month at 6:30pm at Zion UCC.


