


WELCOME BACK, PASTOR ALEX!!!!!

The theme of this summer's Vacation Bible School was being good stewards of God's creation. Our key verse: Psalm 24:1, "The earth is the Lord's and everything in it." Our identity: Our Creator's Crew. Our Mission: Stewardship of God's Creation. Our motto: We have got a job to do 'cause we are the Creator's crew.

When Lauren and I decided to create our own Vacation Bible School curriculum this year, rather than purchasing a packaged program, we knew we would have a lot of work to do. Lauren jumped right in, finding video resources, crafts and games. I began identifying and scheduling local resource people to make presentations to the kids and writing opening and



closing session for each day incorporating Bible verses and stories, music and the daily featured endangered animals that Lauren identified (all native to Illinois). Our guest presenters included a bee keeper, a veterinarian, a Peru Police canine officer and dog, a wildlife rehabilitator from Mendota and the Northern Illinois Raptor Rehab and Education Center. We opened the presentation by the raptor center to families of the students and the public, and we did have about 45 people come.

We had about 35 kids participate during the week. They seemed to especially enjoy the guest presentations and, of course, the waterslide on the last day. Wouldn't you know it, after 4 days of really hot weather, our last day was almost cool. But that did not deter the kids. And of course we finished up with hot dogs, chips, desserts and beverage provided for the kids and their families by the Women's Guild. Overall the week was a big hit.

And it could not have happened without all the people who volunteered to help as registrars, group leaders, craft leaders, games leaders, snack providers, tech support and office support. BIBLE STUDY TO RESUME THIS FALL WITH SEASON 3 OF THE CHOSEN

We were reluctant to take a break over the summer because we were enjoying our session so much, but with everyone's vacations schedules and Pastor Alex's sabbatical it seemed the best thing to do. But we all agreed we wanted to continue in the fall. The exact starting date has not yet been set (we are waiting for consult with Pastor Alex after he gets back) but anticipate that 1) it will be sometime in September and 2) that it will continue to be both in person and on zoom.



IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS GROUP BUT ARE CONCERNED THAT YOU WEREN'T PART WHEN WE DISCUSSED SEASONS 1 AND 2, DO NOT LET THAT HOLD YOU BACK. You can catch up with a little "binge watching" or some more leisurely watching. Here's how.

Step 1 Go to BYUtv on your computer or tablet.

Step 2. Set up an account. They are free and give you access to lots of programs beside "The Chosen".

Step 3. Click on the little magnifying glass at the top of the screen. Then type The Chosen in the search box that appears

Step 4 An icon (picture) for the Chosen will appear. Click on it. Then on episodes.

Step 5 Choose Season 1. Click on Episode 1 and you are on your way.

A few things to keep in mind:

You won't see much of Jesus in the first two episodes. These two episodes mostly introduce some of the disciples who will be following Jesus and give a sense of what their lives might have been like. The creators of this series have drawn on lots of research to present life in the time of Jesus and used their imaginations to flesh out what biblical descriptions we have of the disciples' personalities in a very credible way.

The series does not follow the order of events of any one of the Gospels, but incorporates scenes and events from all of them. And adds some scenes that are not in the Gospels but which help us understand the times, characters and relationships.

You might want to turn on the closed captions. The accents of some of the actors are a little hard to understand at first, and it helps get everybody's names straight.

The episodes are very engaging, but they do sometimes jump back and forth between people and places, and a few start with an event from the Old Testament that will be referred to later in the episode. One resource that provides episode summaries and notes is https://studythechosen.wordpress.com.

Even if you don't take time to watch seasons 1 and 2 you are welcome to join the class when it starts up again.


